




once trees stood tall and grass was green once wa-ter flowed cold and clean




the land gave life we flour-ished here it gave us bi-son birds and deer




how man-y roamed the earth more than the stars




then stran-gers came from a-cross the sea to con-quer earth like an en-e-my
how man-y years till our fears are gone how man-y years must our tears flow on




for-e-ver changed the peace we knew we fear for them for what they do
